



Reticulated Vase with Celadon Glaze

Description

Double-walled vase, the outer wall carved with an openwork floral design. The whole vase covered with a bluish-green celadon glaze. A rare reticulated 'Longquan' celadon bottle vase, the pear shaped body set with a tall neck carved with flowers and upright leaf lappets, the belly pierced through to the smaller inner vase to reveal on the exterior two elegant peonies borne on an undulating leafy stem, applied overall with an unctuous bluish-green glaze pooling in the recesses, all supported on a short foot.
